FinaFog 410 effectively migrates on the polymer surface and helps to form a uniform moisture film, which offers superior visibility through the films.

It exhibits suitable compatibility with plasticizers such as polymeric and epoxidized soya bean oil and possesses adequate stability for compounding.

METHOD OF USE

: By addition during compounding

USE LEVEL

: 2.0 to 4.0 phr (as per end-use requirements)

STORAGE

: It is recommended to store this product at room temperature. At lower temperature, it may crystallize due to its inherent characteristics. The crystallization is reversible when heated and has no influence on application properties.
